# February 2022

A couple days ago Theo was turning the pages of one of my books and started talking to me about the gospels, rightly informing me that there are four of them but incorrectly stating that there are four "synoptic" gospels. There are actually 3 - Matthew, Mark and Luke - as the synoptic gospels generally have the same storylines while the Gospel of John does not resemble the others.

As I explained this to him, I also told him that the word "gospel," translated from the Greek word *eu-angelion*, means "good news." So when we are reading the gospels in our Bibles, we are reading about this good news, which for us is the news of our salvation: before Jesus came along, we had no hope of salvation. Thanks to the lifesaving death and resurrection of Jesus, however, we are redeemed of our sins and our salvation is assured.

This is not just "good news." This is the *best* news!!

While considering this concept – and how we are called by Jesus to *share* this good news – I thought about how important it is for us to share our happiness and joy with others. Thus I am trying to make a more conscious effort to regularly share the joy of my son Theo with you all, as he is a member of our church family and brings his mom and me so much happiness.

I took this picture – which illustrates a typical Theo morning – yesterday morning. I shared it with friends, and this was the caption: "Theo just told me that there is one regular gospel and three synoptic gospels. Two days ago he told me that Obadiah is a book in the Bible and also a prophet. Yesterday he pranced around and recited all the books in the Bible - and the New English apocrypha - in order. ...I only knew he got two wrong because I pulled out the New English once he got started." (note: I have never tried to get Theo to read these books or prompted him to study them...100% of this is self-directed as he always steals my books and just sits and reads them, taking them back off my shelf after I put them away)

Theo is a joy for me; his comings and goings and actions are "news" that is fun and happy and uplifting, and so I try to share it with you – my church family and my friends. This is something we should all do for one another: share our good news always, and not just so that we can grow closer to one another but also so that we can lift each other's spirits regularly. Good news from one of us can help rejuvenate another who is feeling down and out.

Sharing our good news is one of many ways we can faithfully live as church family in fellowship. And sharing our *best* news – the news that Jesus Christ died for us and rose from the dead – that by the cross and

resurrection we are set free and our salvation is assured – is not only an even better way to live out our faith, but it's literally what Jesus has *called* us to do: "Go into all the world and proclaim the good news to the whole creation."

#### The whole creation.

So please, my dear friends: today and all days may we share all of our good news with our friends and family, and may we share our best news – that thanks to Jesus our salvation is assured – with *everyone.* Pastor Mike


